Festival Ballet Providence and Meeting Street presented a pilot program modeled after the very successful Boston Children's Hospital and Boston Ballet dance program designed for children with Down Syndrome.

Participants of both FBP's pilot program and Boston Ballet's ongoing efforts have demonstrated improved motor skills, balance, coordination and overall fitness. Through dance and music, children develop better focus, rhythm and musicality. And, while creating new friendships in such a unique and creative setting, children have also experienced higher levels of self-confidence and self-esteem.

Class size will be limited to ten. All classes will be staffed by members of the Meeting Street therapy team and faculty from FBP's Center for Dance Education.
